RBI HOLDS POLICY RATE, HIKES REVERSE REPO RATE

The central bank said while surplus liquidity in the banking system had fallen in March. The central bank said it had proposed a standing deposit facility to the government in November 2015, approval for which was still awaited. SDF is a mechanism to drain surplus cash at a rate lower than the repo rate without the need for any collateral.
