MID-AIR COLLISION AVERTED AT DELHI AIRPORT

Around 11 a.m., an Air India Delhi-Goa flight (AI 156) that had 122 passengers, including three infants, was given the go-ahead for takeoff by the air traffic control (ATC) from runway 28/10. As the two runways are not parallel and their flight paths are converging, there was a possibility of a mid-air collision.

COLLISION
