Okinawa Autotech opens the second plant in India, to manufacture 10 lakh EVs per year by 2024

Summary:

Okinawa Autotech, an electric two-wheeler company, has opened its second manufacturing facility in Bhiwadi, Rajasthan. The new facility would be able to produce up to three lakh electric vehicles per year, with a capacity of one million or ten lakhs expected in the following two to three years. The Alwar facility has a capacity of 1,80,000 units per year. Over 250 employees will be employed at the new production plant. The company would also invest roughly Rs 250 crore in the creation of new facilities and the development of future innovative products, such as Oki90.

The firm has nearly 400 locations that serve metros, tier 2, 3, and rural regions.
